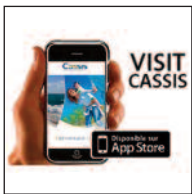

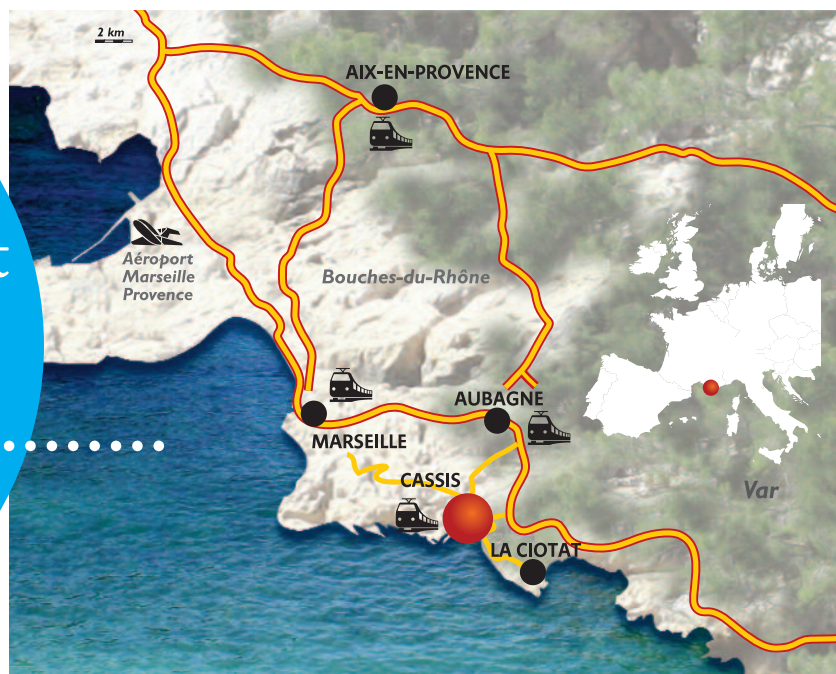

SHORT HISTORY LESSON

- A land occupied since prehistoric times.
- Between the 3rd century BC and the 1st century A.D.: Ligurians lived in the hills of Baou Redon. Carsicis Portus was a harbour that lived mainly off fishing and trade with the Mediterranean.
- From the 5th to the 10th centuries, its inhabitants took refuge on the hilltops (castrum) to escape the Barbarian invasions.
- In the 15th century: Cassis became part of the lands belonging to the Count of Provence. It became French in 1486.
- The town was governed by bishops until 1789.
- In the 18th century, the town expanded around the harbour.
- At the beginning of the 20th century, Cassis became a resort for rich residents of Marseille.

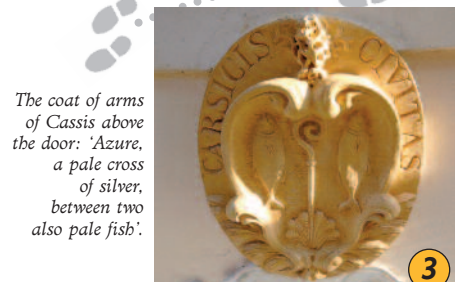
ST-MICHEL CHURCH

Built in the 19th century with Cassis stone.



LE FOUR BANAL (communal oven)

It dates to the 17th century and hosts exhibitions of the traditions of Provence.



LA MAISON DE L'EUROPE ET DE LA VIE ASSOCIATIVE

Formerly the Martin Sauveur mansion, from the 17th century.



LIBRARY - VILLA L'ARIANE

Elegant 19th-century mansion.



TOWN HALL

A former private mansion built by Désiré de Moustiers in the 17th century with a lavish staircase.

The square has a fountain made of Cassis stone. The temporary exhibition space Les Salles Voutées is located nearby.



HIGHLIGHT: CHÂTEAU DE CASSIS

The castle, a fortified town covering 4,850sq. m, overlooking the sea, was home to 250 people in the Middle Ages. It belonged to the powerful Baux family and is now a private residence which is completely enclosed by its high walls, with luxury guest rooms to rent.

PORT-PIN

1-hour walk from the town centre.

The smallest and most intimate of the three Calanques boasts a profusion of Aleppo pines that grow directly out of the rock face. It has a tiny, gently-sloping cove.



EN-VAU

A brisk two-hour walk from the town centre. Please note: the climb down to the 'beach' is not easy.

The most famous and spectacular of the Calanques is picture-postcard beautiful. If you enjoy climbing, you will simply love its steep, jagged white cliffs. And everyone will enjoy a swim in its turquoise waters at the end of the path...

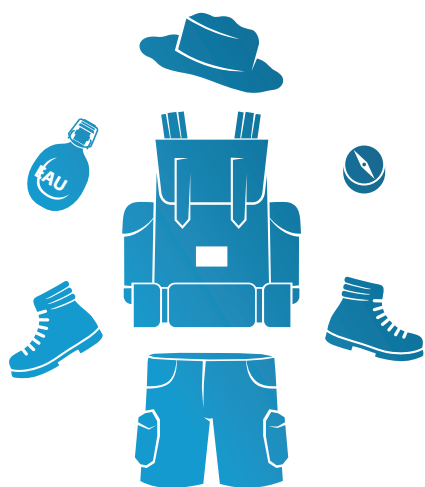

THE CALANQUES WERE FORMED 120 MILLION YEARS AGO



HIGHLIGHT: COSQUER CAVE (Grotte Cosquer) ●●●●●

Cosquer Cave was discovered in 1991 by Henri Cosquer, a former professional diver from Cassis. It is an underground wonderland with prehistoric paintings dating to between 27 000 and 19 000 BC and boasts carvings and paintings of hands, horses... For safety reasons, the cave is closed to the public.

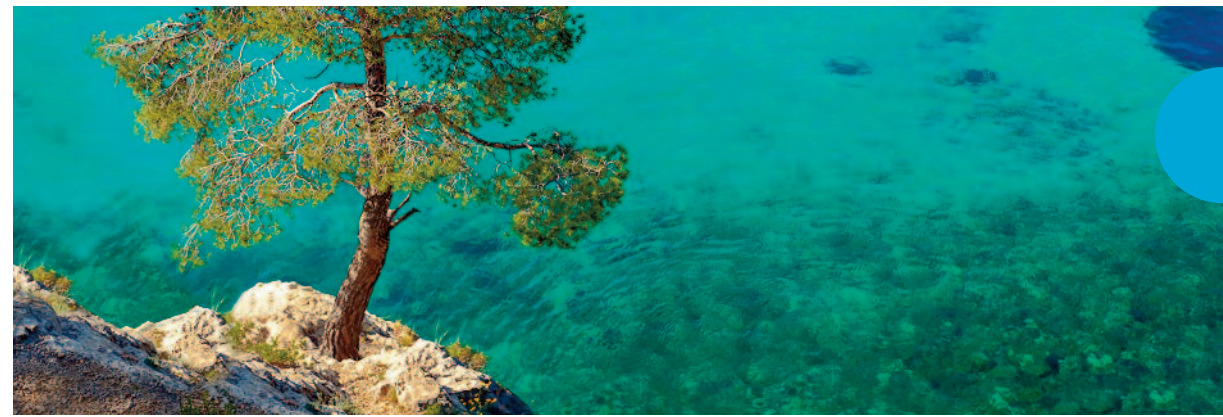
The Massif des Calanques, to the west of Cassis, is made up of a 400-metre-thick layer of white limestone. Marine valleys have been carved out of it, creating **veritable miniature fjords**, often with their own magnificent natural coves.

DID YOU KNOW?



- The Calanques have provided an abundant source of the magnificent 'Cassis stone', for which this tiny fishing harbour is known throughout the world, as it has been used to build Mediterranean ports (Alexandria, Algiers, Piraeus, Marseille...). Today it is used to make decorative objects and souvenirs.

- Underwater springs: the **mysterious rivers...** Fresh water collects in the Massif des Calanques. It is home to an important underwater ecosystem in the sea.



Calanques flora and fauna: an extraordinary treasure...

At every bend in the pathway, you will see **typical cliff and garrigue plant**: sea lavender (limonium), myrtle, wild asparagus, broom, lavatera... and Mediterranean aromatic plants.

There is also a **profusion of wildlife**. If you're lucky, you might see warblers, peregrine falcons, gannets, gulls or a pair of Bonelli's eagles (only 32 in France).

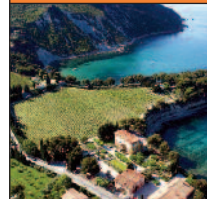

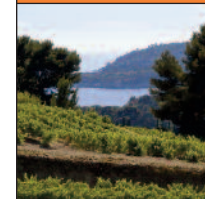

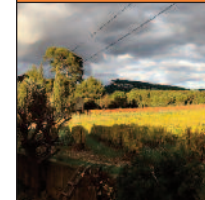
LE CHÂTEAU DE FONTCREUSE 4
